## **Resolution of Appreciation**

### **To The Honorable Blake Farenthold**

Whereas Representative Blake Farenthold is an active member of the Transportation & Infrastructure Committee of the U.S. House of Representatives, and

Whereas Representative Blake Farenthold sponsored H.R. 1535, a bill changing federal law making more miles of the I-69 corridor eligible for interstate designation, gained the co-sponsorship of all his Texas congressional colleagues and succeeded in the measure becoming law; and

Whereas Representative Blake Farenthold has sponsored the formation of the I-69 Congressional Caucus and is serving as Chairman of the Caucus; and

Whereas Representative Blake Farenthold is sponsoring several pieces of legislation that would facilitate the development of I-69 including addition of SH 44 to the I-69 route; seeking exemptions for rural interstate designation; and allowing transition time for weight restrictions on highway upgrades to interstates and grandfather clauses where applicable.; and therefore

Be it resolved, that the Board of Directors of the Alliance for I-69 Texas expresses its keen appreciation for the public service and transportation leadership of the Honorable Blake Farenthold.
